Dr. Sullivan is an Associate Professor (Research) and Implementation Scientist at the Brown University School of Public Health in the Health Services Policy and Practice Department. She also serves as an Associate Director and investigator at the THRIVE COIN at the VA Providence Healthcare System. For more than 20 years, Dr. Sullivan has led research in health services within the VA, securing funding from both VA HSR and QUERI to support a range of studies and evaluations. Her core research focuses on assessing program implementation and the quality of institutional and noninstitutional long-term services and supports (LTSS) in the VA system. Dr. Sullivan's expertise spans mixed-methods and qualitative research designs, as well as the application of implementation science to improve care delivery. She currently co-leads a VA merit grant to evaluate the implementation of Hospital in Home programs within the VA.
